

Privacy Statement

We respect the privacy of our website visitors and ensure that the personal information you provide us is treated confidentially. Processing of personal data is done in a manner that complies with the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

PURPOSES OF DATA PROCESSING

We process your personal data for the purpose of user navigation. If you fill out a contact form on the website or send an email, these data will be retained for as long as necessary for the nature of the form or the content of your email for complete response and handling.

CLICK BEHAVIOR AND VISIT DATA

General visit data is kept on the website. In this context, the IP address of the computer, the possible username, the time of visits, and the data sent by the browser can be registered and used for statistical analyses of website visit and click behavior. We also use this data to optimize the functioning of our website. We try to anonymize this data as much as possible. This data is not provided to third parties.

GOOGLE ANALYTICS

We use Google Analytics to track how visitors use our website. The information obtained, including demographic data and your computer's IP address, is transferred to Google and stored on Google's servers. Google uses this information to track how the website is used, to provide us with reports on the website, and to provide us with information about the effectiveness of user navigation. Google may provide this information to third parties if required by law or if these third parties process the information on behalf of Google. We have no control over this.
